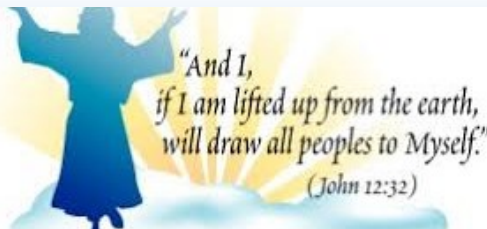
I am looking forward to seeing all of you there.

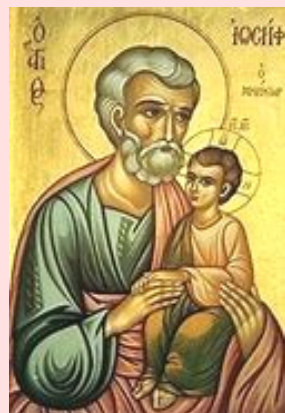
